I. Instruction to Bidders (ITB)

- NND invites Request for Proposals (RFP) through e-procurement portal for Supply and Installation
 of Fiber Reinforced Plastic (FRP) Toilets Under Swachh Bharat Mission as per details given in
 this document as per Uttarakhand Procurement Rules 2017 and subsequent revisions.
- 2. Background of the project Nagar Nigam Dehradun (hereinafter referred to as "NND" or "the Authority"), is capital city and biggest ULB of Uttarakhand which attract tourist in huge numbers. The existing population of the NND is approximately 12 Lacs having 100 municipal wards spread in approximately 200 sq. km. NND delivers waste management and sanitation services in its jurisdiction.

Sanitation is one of the most important core activities of ULBs, of which public toilets in the slum areas and hard to reach commercial areas are of utmost importance. With the lack of space in slum and other commercial areas and vehicular movement it becomes difficult to establish a permanent structure. Moreover, due to heavy traffic, it is not desirable to establish a permanent structure which takes up a lot of space and are high maintenance. Hence NND plans an effective method to achieve targets of cleanliness and sanitation through establishment of space saving Fiber Reinforced Plastic toilets hereinafter referred to as FRP toilets. NND is looking for an agency for supply and installation of FRP toilets that will help in ensuring effective compliances w.r.t. abovementioned activity and contribute in building the city image as Green and Swachh (Hygiene) City.

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- a. To ensure NND to remain and open defecation free (ODF) city in order to maintain the status of newly received Water Plus certification.
- b. To ensure an integrated sanitation solution for slum areas
- To improve the existing standards of public health and environmental quality by establishing efficient mechanism for sanitation
- d. To ensure effective redressal of sanitation related complaints in the slum areas.

4. Scope of work:


- a) The specifications proposed under this contract for the FRP toilets is attached as Annexure -1.
- b) Supply and installation of FRP toilets along with the sewer/septic tank commissioning and a provision for supply of water, as per the specification given in the RFP document.
- The transportation and commissioning of the FRP toilets shall be done by the contractor at no extra cost.
- d) Procure, provide, and maintain necessary tools, equipment, machinery (if necessary) and manpower for the installation of FRP toilets.
- e) NND is purchasing the FRP toilets. Contractor has to supply and install the toilets along with sewer/septic tank and other necessary water arrangements on a turnkey basis.
- f) For any accident, any injury or physical harm to any person is caused by operations during installation, the contractor shall be solely responsible for it and shall bear all the cost associated with such eventualities.
- g) The contractor has to provide one (01) year manufacturer warranty on the FRP toilets which shall be applicable from the date of establishment of FRP toilets.

NND's Scope:

- a) NND shall arrange for and provide the following on free of cost basis: (1) Identified sites for the installation of FRP toilets (2) Provision for electricity
- b) The staff of Health Department of NND shall super-wise and monitor the Contractor's work and services as per the direction of the Competent Authority at all times and notifies the Contractor of any defects found/identified in operation and service level during inspection. Such inspection/checking shall not affect the Contractor's responsibilities. The Contractor shall have to correct a defect and improve service level within the time specified.

Contractor's Responsibilities:

- a) The Contractor shall not modify or alter any specifications without prior permission of the Competent Authority.
- b) The Contractor shall carry out his operations, perform work and provide services so as not to interfere unnecessarily or improperly with the convenience of the public.
- c) Shall be fully responsible for carrying out the operations in a safe and secure manner, consistent with the law of the land, laws and regulations and directives of any Authority and permissions.
- d) The Contractor shall take all necessary precautions to prevent any nuisance or inconvenience to the owners, tenants or occupiers of adjacent properties and to the public in general and to prevent any damage to such properties and any pollution of smoke streams and waterways. He shall make good at his cost and to the satisfaction of the NND any damage to roads parts or public property whatsoever caused there on by the contractor. All waste or superfluous material shall be carried away by the contractor without any reservation entirely to the satisfaction of the NND.
- e) The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of all his activities & his personnel deployed for performing the work and providing services under this contract and shall be absolutely and solely responsible for any and all kinds of injuries or damages to person and property of any description whatever may be caused by or result from the operations carried out, whether



these may have been carried out skillfully and carefully and strictly in conformity with the provisions of the specifications or not.


Payment Terms: The payment shall be done on AS-IS basis upon establishment of FRP toilets along with sewer/septic tank and water tank/provision. The contractor shall raise an invoice upon successful establishment of the FRP at the site along with Geo-Tagged photographs. The NND official will inspect the site and upon verification of the same, the payment shall be made to the contractor & applicable Taxes as per rules shall be deducted and penalties if any shall be deducted.

Qualification criteria:

- Should be a legal entity as per Indian Law. JVs / Consortiums are not allowed. i)
- Should have a valid GST registration. (Copy need to be attached) ii)
- Should have a PAN (Copy need to be attached) iii)
- Should have submitted Bid Document Fees (Rs. One (01) Thousand+18% GST) iv)
- Should have submitted Earnest Money Deposit (Rs. Two (02) Lakhs only) v)
- The bidder should not have been black listed as on the last date of proposal submission by vi) any Ministry / Department / under taking of Government of India or any State or Union Territory Administration.
- Should have achieved an Average Annual Turnover during last three Financial Years of not less than Rs. One (01) Crore. (CA certified Turnover, Balance sheets, P&L accounts for last three F.Y. need to be attached)
- viii) Should have submitted ITR for last three (03) F.Y (copy need to be attached)
- Should have a net positive worth (as on 31st March 2023) ix)
- Affidavit as per format provided in Annexure 9. X)
- Past performance: xi)
 - i. Contractor must have work order and experience of successful supply and installation of FRP toilets in any Govt agency/ULB in India.
- 6. The Bidders should submit along with the proposal, all relevant documents to establish their eligibility and also for meeting Qualification Criteria.
- Due diligence by bidders bidders are encouraged to inform themselves fully about the assignment and the local conditions before submitting the bid by visiting project sites. It would be deemed that before submitting the proposal, the bidder has made a complete and careful examination of terms and conditions/requirements, and other information set forth in this RFP. Received all such information as it has requested from NND.
- 8. Tender fee of Rs. 1,180 (Rs. 1000 + GST 18%) to be paid in the form of Demand Draft in favor of Nagar Nigam Dehradun on or before technical proposal submission date. In case of non-payment within this time, the proposal shall be summarily rejected.

Earnest Money:

- The Earnest Money is Rs. 2,00,000/= (two lakhs only), to be paid in the form of FDR in favor (i) of Nagar Nigam Dehradun.
- The Earnest Money shall be returned to unsuccessful Bidders within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of announcement of the Successful Service Provider. The Earnest Money (ii) submitted by the Successful Bidder shall be released upon furnishing of the Performance
- The Successful Service Provider's Earnest Money will be returned, without any interest, upon the signing of the Contract Agreement and furnishing the Performance Security in (iii) accordance with the provisions thereof.
- The Earnest Money shall be forfeited in the following cases: (iv)
 - (a) If the Bidder withdraws its proposal during the interval between the last date for proposal submission and expiration of the proposal Validity Period; and



(b) If the Successful Bidder fails to provide the Performance Security within the stipulated time or any extension thereof provided by NND.

10. Proposal Preparation Cost:

- (i) The Bidders shall be responsible for all the costs associated with the preparation of its proposal and its participation in the bidding process. NND will not be responsible or in any way liable for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of bidding.
- (ii) Site inspections and visits to the site and related costs to the work. It is desirable that each bidder submits proposals after due visiting the site.

11. Clarifications:

Bidders requiring any clarification on the tender document may upload the queries on website: www.uktenders.gov.in or through e-mail (with subject- query FRP Toilets RFP) at nagarnigam.ddn@gmail.com prior to the time and date given in the Tender Schedule.

12. Amendment of Proposal:


- (i) At any time prior to the proposal due date, NND may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to clarifications requested by a Service Provider, modify the proposal through Addendum / Corrigendum which will be posted on the website: www.uktenders.gov.in only.
- (ii) In order to afford Bidders reasonable time in which to take an Addendum into account, or for any other reason, NND may, at its own discretion, extend the proposal due date.

13. Validity of Proposal:

- (i) The proposal shall be valid for not less than 120 (One hundred twenty) days from the last date for proposal submission (but excluding the day of proposal submission). Proposals of lesser validity shall be summarily rejected as non-responsive.
- (ii) Prior to expiry of the original Proposal Validity Period, NND may request that the Bidders extend the period of validity for a specified additional period. A Bidders may refuse the request without forfeiting its Earnest Money. The proposal of any Bidders refusing to extend the Earnest Money shall be returned and shall not be included in the further proposal process. A Bidders agreeing to the request of extending the Earnest Money will not be allowed to modify its proposal, but would be required to extend the validity of its Earnest Money for the period of extension.

14. Pre-Proposal Meeting:

- (i) To clarify and discuss issues with respect to the work and the proposal, a Pre-Proposal meeting will be held on the date, time and place indicated in the Tender Schedule given on Page no. 3 of this document, Attendance of the bidders at the Pre-Proposal meeting is not mandatory. <u>But it is highly recommended to attend for understanding the provisions of RFP and Selection process.</u>
- (ii) During the course of Pre-Proposal conferences, the Bidders will be free to seek clarifications and make suggestions for consideration of NND. NND shall endeavor to provide clarifications and such further information as it may, in its sole discretion, consider appropriate for facilitating a fair, transparent and competitive bidding process.
- 15. Bidders may note that NND will not entertain any deviations to the proposal at the time of submission of the proposal or thereafter. The proposal to be submitted by the Bidders will be unconditional and unqualified and the Bidders would be deemed to have accepted the terms and conditions of the proposal with all its contents including the Contract. Any conditional proposal shall be regarded as non-responsive and shall be rejected.
- 16. No interpretation, revision, or other communication from NND regarding this solicitation is valid

1. Format, Preparation and Submission of Proposal:

- Bidders would provide all the information as per this proposal and in the specified formats.
 NND reserves the right to reject any proposal that is not in the specified formats.
- The proposal should be submitted in two folders as provided in the e-portal Technical and Financial Proposals.
- iii) Covering Letter as per format given in Annexure 4
- iv) Technical proposal folder should include:
 - All the documents required as per this RFP except Financial Proposal.

 No financial information like price should be given in the Technical proposal, in which

case the proposal shall be summarily rejected. Tender fee and EMD online or offline deposit scanned receipt has to be uploaded along with technical proposal.

- v) Financial proposal folder: As per BoQ in the financial folder.
- vi) The Bidders shall prepare and submit online through website: <u>www.uktenders.gov.in</u> scanned copies of original documents comprising the proposal as described above.
- vii) Proposals should be submitted / uploaded on the website: www.uktenders.gov.in only.
 Submission of Proposals through any other mode is not acceptable and shall be rejected.
 NND, at its sole discretion, may extend the last date for proposal submission proposal submission by issuing an Addendum on the website: www.uktenders.gov.in only.
- viii) Late Proposals: It may be noted that the e-portal will not accept any proposal after the specified due time as per its server clock.
- ix) The Bidders is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the tender document. Failure to furnish all information required by the bidding documents or submission of a proposal not substantially responsive to the tender document in every respect will be at the Service Provider's risk and may result in rejection of its proposal.
- The (a) Original Affidavit (as per format) and (9) Original Tender fee and EMD. Original documents are required, the prospective bidder shall submit these original documents before submission of last date.

18. Modification and Withdrawal of Proposals:

- (i) The Bidders may modify or withdraw its proposal on e-portal before the proposal due date and time. However, no proposal can be modified or withdrawn thereafter.
- (ii) Withdrawal of a proposal during the interval between the proposal due date and expiration of the proposal Validity Period would result in forfeiture of the Earnest Money.
- 19. NND reserves the right to reject any proposal which in its opinion is non-responsive and no request for modification or withdrawal shall be entertained by NND in respect of such proposals.
- Conditional proposal shall not be considered. Any proposal found to contain conditions attached, shall be rejected.

21. Proposal Opening:

- (i) Bidders' representatives who choose to be present may attend the proposal opening.
- (ii) If the office happens to be closed on pre-proposal meeting or proposal opening day, same stands postponed to the next working day without any change in time or venue. <u>However</u>, there will be no change in Proposal submission date on e-portal, unless it is also extended.



Confidentiality:

- In case of the bidders, any act of interference or attempt to influence the personnel associated with the evaluation shall be viewed seriously; and may also result in declaring the proposal as invalid.
- (ii) Information relating to the examination, clarification, evaluation and recommendation shall not be disclosed to any person not officially concerned with the process. NND will treat all information submitted as part of proposal in confidence and will ensure that all who have access to such material treat it in confidence. NND will not divulge any such information unless it is ordered to do so by any Government authority that has the power under law to require its disclosure.

23. Clarifications:

- (i) To assist in the process of evaluation of proposals, NND may, at its sole discretion, ask any Bidder for clarification including additional information and documents. In case of any additional documents, same can be accepted only if they are of historical nature i.e., either the documents or facts in the documents should have existed prior to be proposal submission time and same could be verified independently. However, no change in the substance of the proposal would be permitted by way of such clarifications. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing or e-mail or by facsimile.
- (ii) NND reserves the right to independently verify by a team of Officers of NND or independently facts and figures provided in the documents submitted by the Service Providers; in addition to right to disqualify, reject and/ or accept any and all submissions or other information and/ or evidence submitted by or on behalf of any Service Provider.
- (iii) Bidders shall fill up the required information as per the prescribed proposal form. If any Bidder does not fill up the information properly, NND has a right to reject such proposals.

24. Proposal Evaluation:

- To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of proposals, NND may utilize the services of consultant/s or advisor/s.
- (ii) Evaluation of Proposals will be done in two stages first the Technical Proposal i.e., the bidders, who meet qualification criteria shall be considered as technically responsive:

Thereafter, only their financial proposals shall be opened.

- (iii) The Bidder who has submitted the lowest evaluated responsive proposal shall be deemed to be the preferred service provider.
- (iv) Proposal submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- (v) With regard to qualification criteria; and bidders' responsiveness, the interpretation and decision of the Technical Evaluation Committee shall be final and binding on all Bidders.
- (vi) The Financial Bids of technically qualified Bidders will be opened on the prescribed date in the presence of Bidders' representatives.
- (vii) Any conditional bid would be rejected
- (viii) Proposals shall be deemed to be under consideration immediately after they are opened and until such time NND makes official intimation of award/ rejection to the Bidders. While the Proposals are under consideration, Bidders and / or their representatives or other interested parties are advised to refrain from contacting NND and or their employees/ representatives on matters related to the Proposals under consideration by any means.

25. NND's Right to Accept or Reject Proposal:

(i) NND reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the proposals without assigning any
reason and to take any measure as it may deem fit, including annulment of the bidding process,

- (ii) NND reserves the right to reject any proposal including that of the Preferred Bidder if:
 - at any time, a material misrepresentation is made or uncovered; If a fraud or fraudulent practice adopted by any Bidder is established, the Bidder may be blacklisted and /or appropriate legal proceedings may be initiated against such Bidder as per the prevailing laws, OR
 - (b) the Bidder does not respond promptly and thoroughly to requests for supplemental information required for the evaluation of the proposal.
 - take any such measure as may be deemed fit in the sole discretion of NND, including annulment of the bidding process.

26. Negotiation:

Ordinarily no negotiation shall be done. However, where price negotiation is necessary in the opinion of NND same shall be resorted to with the preferred Service Provider.

27. Notifications:

- (i) Upon acceptance of the Financial Proposal of the Preferred Bidder with or without negotiations, NND shall declare the preferred Bidder as the successful Service Provider.
- (ii) NND will notify the Successful Bidder by facsimile or e-mail and by a letter (Speed Post / Registered Post) that its proposal has been accepted.

28. Acceptance of Notification of Award (NOA):


Within Seven (7) days from the date of issue of the NOA, the Successful Bidder shall confirm their acceptance of the NOA.

29. Execution of Contract:

The successful bidder shall be issued the Letter of Acceptance (LoA). After issuance of the LoA in writing, and acceptance of the same by the successful bidder within 7 (seven) days, the successful bidder shall enter into an Agreement (draft enclosed with the RFP document) with NND within 30 (thirty) days of conveying his acceptance of the LoA, or on the date as mutually agreed between the Parties to the Agreement.

30. Performance Security:

- (i) Before signing of the Contract, the preferred bidder shall furnish Performance Security for an amount equal to 5% of contract value including GST by way of an irrevocable and unconditional Bank Guarantee (Annexure 4) issued by a scheduled bank located in India in favor of Nagar Nigam, Dehradun with validity for 60 (sixty) days beyond the performance of the Contract.
- (ii) Performance Security shall be submitted within 15 days after LoA/Work Order. If the Initial Security Deposit is not paid within 15 days from the date of LoA/ Work Order than penalty at the rate of 0.065% per day of the amount of Security Deposit will be charged.
- (iii) The Performance security shall be forfeited and en-cashed in the following cases:
 - (a) If the Contractor withdraws midway during the work completion, or
 - (b) Any other act or acts of the contractor which renders the work un-operational and Nagar Nigam, Dehradun establishes sufficient reasons to forfeit the Performance Security.
- (iv) Failure of the bidder to furnish the Performance Security shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award in which event the Nagar Nigam, Dehradun may make the award to the bidder, who has submitted next higher Financial Proposal or call for new Proposals.
- 31. Blacklisting for failure to sign the Contract or its execution: Withdrawing the proposal or failure to sign the Contract or its execution after signing shall result in blacklisting of the bidder including JV Consortium partner/s, if any. The blacklisting shall be effective from the date of notice issued by NND for a period of three years except under force majeure circumstances, in addition to forfeiture of EMD or Performance Security, if already submitted.



32. Language and Currency: The request for arbitration, the answer to the request, the terms of reference, any written submission, any orders and awards shall be either in English or Hindi and, if oral hearings take place, English or Hindi shall be the only language to be used in the hearings. The proposal and all related correspondence and documents should be written in English OR Hindi. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by bidder with the proposal may be in any other language provided that their accompanied by appropriate translations of the pertinent passages in the English language. The currency for the proposal shall be the Indian National Rupees (INR).

33. Debriefing and Appellate:


- Any bidder may request in writing to Municipal Commissioner, NND for debriefing after award of contract.
- (ii) Any bidder may also choose to submit representation to Municipal Commissioner, Nagar Nigam Dehradun, who may take appropriate decision and action based on the merit of the case
- 34. Payment terms: The payment shall be done on AS-IS basis upon establishment of FRP toilets along with sewer/septic tank and water tank/provision. The contractor shall raise an invoice upon successful establishment of the FRP at the site along with Geo-Tagged photographs. The NND official will inspect the site and upon verification of the same, the payment shall be made to the contractor & applicable Taxes as per rules shall be deducted and penalties if any shall be deducted.

35. Penalty:

- a) Penalty for delay: In case of delay in execution of work the penalty at the rate of 0.2% of contract value per day subject to the maximum of 5% of the contract value for works, shall be payable by the contractor to NND towards compensation. Hence, overall penalty for the delay shall be limited to maximum up to 5% of contract value. However, Delay in excess of two months after the start date of work, may be cause for termination of contract and forfeiture of all security for performance.
- b) Any legal non-compliance noticed by NND officials: Rs. 1000/- per non-compliance as identified by the NND officials, apart from the above indicated penalty points.

36. Dispute Resolution:

- a. Any dispute and or difference arising out of or relating to this contract will be resolved through joint discussion of the authorized representatives of both the parties. However, if the dispute is not resolved by joint discussion, then the matter will be referred for adjudication to a soul arbitrator appointed by the Commissioner, NND
- b. The arbitration proceedings shall be governed by Indian arbitration and conciliation act, 1996 as amended from time to time
- c. The cost of arbitration shall be borne by both the parties in equal proportion. Arbitration proceedings will be held at Dehradun only.
- 37. Jurisdiction of Court: The courts at Dehradun shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to try all disputes, if any, arising out of the agreement between the parties.
- 38. Termination Clause: Termination clause on the bidder will be applied accordingly mentioned below:
 - a) NND without prejudice to any other remedy for breach of contract, by notice of default sent to the agency, may terminate the contract in whole or part.
 - b) If the agency fails to deliver any or all the services mentioned in scope of work within the time period specified in the contract or within extension thereof granted by NND.



- c) NND may terminate the contract in whole or part. The Authority may terminate the contract, not less than 15 days after written notice of termination to the bidder, such notice will be issued after the occurrence of events specified for the termination of this agreement.
- d) If the bidder fails to perform any other obligation under the contract.
- e) If the bidder, in the judgment of NND, has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices while executing the project
- f) Any document or information submitted by the bidder in its proposal, based on which the agency was considered eligible or successful is found to be false, incorrect or misleading

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ONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Definitions 1.

- In this Contract, the following terms shall be interpreted as indicated: 1.1

Liquidated Damages:

If the service provider delays to commence the services beyond the agreed date of each timeline, then the liquidated damages @ 0.5% of Performance Security value per week with maximum up to performance security amount shall be levied. Thereafter, NND has the option to terminate the Contract.

9. Taxes and Duties:

- (g) no representation or warranty by the Contractors contained herein or in any other document furnished by it to NND or to any Government Agency in relation to Applicable Permits contains or will contain any untrue statement of material fact or omits or will omit to state a material fact necessary to make such representation or warranty not misleading
- (h) no bribe or illegal gratification has been paid or will be paid in cash or kind to any person to influence the Bidding process.
- (i) Without prejudice to any express provision contained in this Contract Agreement, the Contractor acknowledges that prior to the execution of Agreement under this Contract, the Contactor has after a complete and careful examination made an independent evaluation of the existing facilities and infrastructure such as workshop and office spaces vehicles/containers, service area and the information provided by NND, and has determined to his satisfaction the nature and extent of risks and hazards as are likely to arise or may be faced by Contractor in the course of performance of his obligations here under

The NND represents and warrants to Contractor for the term of this Contract that:

- (a) NND has full power and authority to award this Contract.
- (b) NND has taken all necessary actions to authorize the execution of this Contract

Obligation to Notify Change:

In the event that any of the representations or warranties made/given by a Party cease to be true or stands changed, the Party who has made such representation or given such warranty shall promptly notify the other of the same.

12. Communications

Communications between Parties, which are referred to in the conditions are effective only when in writing. A notice shall be effective only when it is delivered to NND (in terms of Indian Contract Act). All instructions, notices, communications, etc. under the Contract shall be given in writing and shall be either in Hindi or English. If sent by registered post to the last known place or abode or business of the Contractor shall be deemed to have been served on the date.

13. Contractor's Responsibilities:

The Contractor shall not modify or alter any specifications without prior permission of the Competent Authority. The Contractor shall carry out his operations, perform work and provide services so as not to interfere unnecessarily or improperly with the convenience of the public. Shall be fully responsible for carrying out the operations in a safe and secure manner, consistent with the law of the land, laws and regulations and directives of any Authority and permissions. The Contractor shall be responsible for the safety of all his activities & his personnel deployed for performing the work and providing services under this contract and shall be absolutely and solely responsible for any and all kinds of injuries or damages to person and property of any description whatever may be caused by or result from the operations carried out, whether these may have been carried out skillfully and carefully and strictly in conformity with the provisions of the specifications or not.

14. Indemnification:

The Contractor shall indemnify and keep indemnified the Corporation against all losses and claims for injuries or damage to any person or any property whatsoever which may arise out of or in consequence of the operations and against all claims, demands, proceedings, damages, costs, charges and expenses whatsoever in respect of or in relation thereto.

viii Any other relevant act or any modifications thereof and rules made there under from time to time or as a consequence or any accident or injury to any workman or other persons in or about the operations, and also against all cost, charges and expenses of any suit, action or proceedings arising out of such accident or injury and against all sum or sums which may with the consent of the Contractor be paid to compromise or compound any such claim without limiting his/her obligations and liabilities as above provided.

15. Contractor's Superintendence:

The Contractor shall provide all necessary superintendence while carrying out his operations for the proper fulfilling of the Contractor's obligations under the Contract. The Contractor shall nominate a



competent and authorized representative ("Contractor's Representative") approved by the Competent Authority, which approval may at any time be withdrawn. The Contractor's Representative shall give his whole time to the superintendence of the operations and shall receive, on behalf of the Contractor, instructions from the Health Officer/Chief Sanitary Inspectors/Zonal Officers, which shall be deemed received by the Contractor. If the Competent Authority withdraws approval of the representative, the Contractor shall remove the representative from the operations within thirty (30) days, and replace him by another representative approved by the Competent Authority.

16. Reporting:

The Contractor shall carry out all reporting to the concerned monitoring officers and Health Officer of NND as follows.

 A weekly summary of work carried out shall be submitted to the Chief Municipal Health Officer (CMHO) weekly in Format required by NND.

17. Contract Price:

The Contract Price shall cover all expenditure incurred on supply, installation, labor, and any other expenses, The Contract Price shall also include all duties, taxes, that may be levied in accordance to the laws and regulation in-force on the Contractor's equipment, materials, supplies (permanent, temporary and consumables) to be used on or furnished under the Contract and on the operations to be performed under the Contract. Nothing in the Contract shall relieve the Contractor from his responsibility to pay any Tax that may be levied on its operations or on profits made by him in respect of the Contract. The Contractor shall pay Taxes on all payments made to him under the Contract. The Contractor shall pay all the Taxes directly to the Government of Uttarakhand and to the Government of India or to the concerned department. NND shall not take any responsibility for any kind of Tax payment to the Government or Quasi-Government bodies at any point of time, other than those required to be deducted at source before the payments are made to the Contractor under any law & those practice to the NND. The Contractor shall perform such duties in regard to such deductions thereof as may be imposed on him by such laws and regulations.


